

### Tokio Marine Group's Disaster Risk Reduction Initiatives won Japan Resilience Award 2017

We proudly announce that Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) initiatives of “Disaster Prevention Lesson” and “Business Continuity Plan (BCP) Workshop in collaboration with local governments and chambers of commerce” by Tokio Marine & Nichido Fire Insurance Co., Ltd. (President: Toshifumi Kitazawa, hereinafter “TMNF”) won “Best Resilience Award” and “Excellent Resilience Award” respectively at the Japan Resilience Award 2017(\*). Also, initiatives of “Rethink Now ! Earthquake in the Foreseeable Future and Preparation for it” and “Easy, Understandable BCP Planning Sheet” by TMNF and Tokio Marine & Nichido Risk Consulting Co., Ltd. (President: Naruki Yasuda, hereinafter “TRC”) won “Excellent Resilience Award”.

(\*) “Japan Resilience Award” is an award hosted by Association for Resilience Japan, which seeks, evaluates and prizes corporations and/or organizations conducting distinguishing initiatives to create resilient country, communities, people and businesses for building resilient society for the future generation.

#### 【Award-winning initiatives】

Initiative/Award	Content
TMNF's Disaster Prevention Lesson /Best Resilience Award (Risk communication and information)	<p>This is a program aiming to raise readiness for disaster prevention among school children conducted by volunteer employees who wanted to contribute to disaster-resilient society by making use of their own knowledge and expertise. Based on the lessons learned from the 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake, TMNF started to conduct the lesson by using educational materials originally developed by TRC employees and then supervised by International Research Institute of Disaster Science (IRIDeS) of Tohoku University.</p> <p>Tokio Marine Group's employees and agents as instructors have conducted approx. 300 lessons for approx. 20,000 elementary school children, etc. throughout Japan (as of March 2017).</p> <p>In 2016, Tokio Marine &amp; Nichido Fire Insurance Company (China) initiated Disaster Prevention Lesson in China. Tokio Marine Group is expanding its DRR awareness raising initiatives worldwide.</p>
TMNF's BCP Workshop in collaboration with local governments and chambers of commerce /Excellent Resilience Award	<p>This is a BCP planning support program for small to medium-sized companies (SMCs) provided by approx. 100 employees at TMNF who had finished required training programs for instructor. The workshops are hosted in collaboration with local governments, chambers of commerce, financial institutions, etc., and participation is free of charge.</p> <p>In contrast to an ordinary one-way seminar, the workshop starts with a virtual experience of the earthquake which makes participants feel strong needs for BCP. Then, participants work on formulating the key substance of BCP in a groupwork style. Furthermore, the lecturers follow up the participants until</p>

	the completion of BCP planning after the workshop. More than 50 workshops have already been convened across Japan, and more than 300 companies have participated in the workshops.
TMNF and TRC's "Rethink Now! Earthquake in the Foreseeable Future and Preparation for it" and "Easy, Understandable BCP Planning Sheet" / Excellent Resilience Award	TMNF and TRC jointly developed an earthquake-risk awareness raising brochure "Rethink Now! Earthquake in the Foreseeable Future and Preparation for it", and "Easy, Understandable BCP Planning sheet" which enables SMCs to overlook the big picture of BCP and take their first steps for formulating their own BCP. These tools are expected to support SMCs and their supply chains to enhance the level of overall BCP and accordingly improve the effectiveness of the BCP through ensuring employees understand necessary information. As of March 2017, eleven kinds of BCP Planning Sheet are available for industries of manufacturing, construction, retailing, transportation, hotel, elderly care facility, etc., and more than 40,000 brochures have been distributed to companies, local governments and chambers of commerce through Tokio Marine Group employees and agents.

In addition, "Research on the Effects of Tsunami Risk Reduction by the Coastal Forest in the Great East Japan Earthquake and Tsunami - toward the Disaster Prevention and Mitigation by the Natural Coastal Forest and Ecosystem by Earthquake-induced Tsunami Risk Evaluation (TMNF) Endowed Research Division of Tohoku University's IRIDeS", a Tohoku University and Tokio Marine Group's industry-academia collaborative initiative, won "Excellence Award" at the newly established "Green Resilience Award".

Resolving disaster issues and mitigating damages are urgent issues for us. Tokio Marine Group works on initiatives to create safe, secure and sustainable future with a focus on three core CSR themes (Providing safety and security, Protecting the Earth, and Supporting people) together with local communities through our entire business operations from providing product & services for DRR to disaster prevention awareness raising initiatives for children and business entities.
