

## **Tokio Marine Holdings Selected as an "A List Company" by CDP**

Tokio Marine Holdings, Inc. (President and Group CEO: Masahiro Koike, hereinafter "TMHD") has been selected as an "A-list Company" for the third consecutive year, the highest rating in the climate change survey by the international environmental not-for-profit charity CDP\*1.

\*1 CDP: An international environmental not-for profit charity (headquartered in London) that has a system for environmental information disclosure. Its main activities include requesting companies and local governments to disclose information on climate change measures and promoting climate change measures. ([www.cdp.net](http://www.cdp.net))

### **1. Climate Change Survey by CDP**

The evaluation process for environmental information disclosure by CDP is widely recognized as the global standard for corporate environmental information disclosure. In fiscal year 2025, over 22,100 companies worldwide (approximately 2,100 companies in Japan) disclosed information to CDP.

Companies are evaluated based on their responses regarding their efforts to address climate change, and they are assigned scores ranging from A to D-.

### **2. Selected as an "A-list Company"**

Promotion of the following initiatives, as well as strengthened disclosures on governance, strategy, risk management, and metrics and targets through our Climate & Nature Report and other publications, contributed to this year's results.

- (1) Driven by our purpose, Tokio Marine Group positions climate action as a material issue (materiality) we must address as a global company. To achieve net zero carbon emissions by 2050, we have been working on engaging with our customers and providing products and services that support our customers' transition towards decarbonization.
- (2) To further accelerate our climate change initiatives on a global scale in relation to our products and services, Tokio Marine Group launched a new international offering, Tokio Marine GX, in May 2025\*2. Additionally, we set interim targets for engagement with our large corporate clients, as well as group-based interim targets for transition products/services\*3.
- (3) Tokio Marine & Nichido Fire Insurance Co., Ltd., our core P&C company in Japan, has been conducting mangrove planting initiatives, mainly in Southeast Asia, since 1999. In addition to helping prevent and mitigate global warming by absorbing and sequestering CO2, these efforts contribute to biodiversity conservation and strengthening the resilience of coastal areas.
